

Como llenar tu aplicación

Es muy importante que para llenar tu aplicación de la forma correcta, sigas las siguientes instrucciones. Sabemos que puede parecer mucha información sin embargo te será de mucha ayuda para no cometer errores. Te sugerimos hacer un primer borrador de tu información para después pasarla en limpio.

Instrucciones generales

- Recordá que debés tener entre 18 y 26 años para poder viajar como Au pair. Podrás llenar tu aplicación y ser entrevistada aunque aún no tengas 18 pero solo podrás viajar hasta cumplir los 18 años.
- Se seleccionará una familia de acuerdo a tu aplicación por lo que debes ser honesta, sincera y llenar la aplicación vos misma. Todas las preguntas son muy importantes así que no dejes ninguna sin contestar, de otro modo las familias podrían no considerarte.
- Contestá de forma clara y limpia, usa tinta negra y en caso de cometer algún error NO uses corrector, empieza un nuevo formato. Recordá que son muchas las aplicantes por lo que debes demostrar a través de tu aplicación que vos sos la mejor candidata para ser su Au pair.
- Si requerís más espacio, puedes anexar más hojas pero marca claramente dónde continúan tus respuestas.
- Debido a que tu aplicación será escaneada, asegúrate de usar fotografías de buena calidad, usar tinta negra y en caso de usar hojas extra, que sean de colores claros.
- Una vez completada tu información, guardá una copia por si se llegara a extraviar en el correo, camino a Boston. Si enviás documentos importantes como certificados o diplomas, no envías el original, solo una copia.

Aplicación página 1

Foto: Poné una foto donde te veas contenta y sonriente. Recordá la imagen es muy importante, a los niños les gustará tener una Au Pair sonriente. Si tenés algún piercing, deberás considerar sacártelo para la foto y durante tu estadía en USA ya que la mayoría de las familias prefieren un Au pair sin piercing. Esta foto será la primera impresión que tenga la familia de vos, así que procurá que sea la mejor.



Pregunta #1

Escribe tu nombre COMPLETO tal cual aparece en tu pasaporte incluyendo tu segundo nombre. No escribas apodos o abreviaciones ya que puede causar problemas para tu visa!

Pregunta #2

Teléfono de tu casa: Country code- 54. Area code (la de tu ciudad sin el 0 inicial)- Local number (tu teléfono). **Celular:** Country code- 54. Area code (la de tu ciudad sin el 0 inicial y agregá un 9)- el número de tu celular, sin el 15. No te olvides de marcar la opción que indica en que número es más fácil localizarte. Recordá avisarnos si tu teléfono cambia durante el proceso de ubicación dado que no podremos ubicarte con una familia si no logramos contactarte.

Correo electrónico: Una alternativa fácil para que tanto nosotros como las familias se puedan comunicar con vos. Asegurate de revisar tu correo constantemente, puede suceder que al no reconocer la dirección de correo de quien te escribe, se vaya al correo no deseado, revisalo también. Algunas direcciones de correo electrónico podrían no causar buena impresión (por ejemplo: *crazygirl@hotmail.com* o *kissme@gmail.com*), te sugerimos tomarlo en cuenta.

Pregunta #3

Birth date: Deberás escribir **primero el mes**, luego el día y al final el año.

City of birth: La ciudad donde naciste, como lo dice tu pasaporte o partida de nacimiento

Home country: El país donde vivís.

Nationality/ citizenship: tu nacionalidad, por ejemplo: argentina.

Pregunta #4

Sin importar que no vivas con tus papás, que estén divorciados o separados, debes completar esta información.

Pregunta #5

Escribí el nombre de tus hermanos, sexo y año de nacimiento, ejemplo; Macarena, femenino, 1982

Pregunta #6 y 7

Escribí todos los idiomas que sabés, no olvides mencionar el Inglés.

Pregunta #8

Indicá si actualmente estás terminando el secundario, cursando la universidad o si trabajás.

Pregunta #9

Anotá el mes/año en que terminaste la secundaria, o que vas a terminar.

Pregunta #10 y 10ª

Al mencionar el año que cursas de universidad, indicá el número de años. Por ejemplo “2 de 4”, es decir que vas en el segundo año de cuatro. A la pregunta ¿qué estás estudiando? Sólo anota la carrera, ejemplo: “Turismo”.

Pregunta #13

Mencioná empleos y practicas profesionales etc.

Aplicación página 2**Pregunta #14**

En la primera línea decinos cuando comenzaste a manejar y qué tan seguido lo hacías antes de obtener tu licencia (“una vez a la semana, diario”). En la segunda línea asegurate de que anotes la información correcta, tal cual aparece en tu licencia. En la última línea, escribí si, solo si vos ibas manejando. Es muy importante que sepas que una de tus principales actividades como Au Pair será manejar con los niños en el auto, así que debes ser una buena conductora, experimentada y segura, no solo esta tu vida de por medio, sino la de los niños. **NO MIENTAS SOBRE TU EXPERIENCIA!**

Pregunta #15

Esta pregunta es muy importante! Por favor sé honesta. El 90 % de las familias no te elegirá si sos fumadora, no importa si lo hacés solo los fines de semana o todos los días. Es muy importante que consideres dejar de fumar a la hora de aplicar. Si fumás, escribe detalladamente con qué frecuencia. Realiza una pequeña carta donde expliques el por qué fumas, en dónde, qué tan seguido lo haces y si estarías dispuesta a no fumar dentro de la casa ni cerca de los niños. En caso de que la familia te permita fumar fuera de la casa, recuerda que no puedes dejar a los niños solos para salir a fumar. Debido a que pocas familias aceptan personas que fuman, debes saber que nos tomará más tiempo de lo normal encontrar una familia por lo que también te pedimos apliques con tiempo de anticipación.

Por otro lado también tené en cuenta que si mientes en tu aplicación, la familia puede pedir tu cambio por lo que te recomendamos ser honesta.

Pregunta #16

Si elegís “No” explicá el por qué. Para los americanos “pets” se refiere a perros, gatos, pájaros, peces, caballos etc. En caso de no poder vivir con algún tipo de animal, especificá las razones (alergias, miedo, etc.)

Pregunta #17

En caso de que tengas algún tatuaje o piercing anexá una hoja explicando dónde lo tienes y qué tienes. Si tenés un piercing, es muy recomendable que te lo saques y que en la aplicación no lo menciones. Y con respecto a los tatuajes, si es posible anexá una fotografía del tatuaje que tenés.

Pregunta #18

Asegurate de escribir tu religión o marcar el cuadro de non-denominational (que significa que no profesas ninguna religión)

Pregunta #19

Si tenés alguna alergia, agregá una explicación sobre que tipo de alergia es y como la controlas.

Pregunta #20 y 21

Si marcas “Yes” explica en detalle, y menciona si estarías dispuesta a cocinar alimentos fuera de esa dieta. Por ejemplo en caso de ser vegetariana, si prepararías un sándwich con jamón a tus niños. Y si sigues o no alguna dieta, estarías dispuesta a vivir con una familia que si la tenga? Por ejemplo, una familia judía con dieta Kosher o con vegetarianos?

Pregunta #22

Se refiere a si has vivido sola por más de 2 meses.

Pregunta #23

Escribí todos tus intereses, cuantos más sean, mejor!

Pregunta #25

Saber nadar es muy importante para la mayoría de las familias así que indicanos que tan bien sabes nadar.

Aplicación página 3-4

Pregunta #26^a

Esta es la parte más importante de la aplicación. Realizá un borrador para evitar errores. Anotá detalladamente toda la experiencia que tengas con niños, entre mayor sea, es mejor! Comenzá con la experiencia más reciente. Sé muy específica sobre tu experiencia cuidando niños entre 0 y 2 años.

En el lado izquierdo:

En Type of childcare anotá si sos maestra, niñera, líder de un campamento, etc. Seleccioná si vos los cuidabas sola o si estabas con alguien más. Anotá el nombre de los niños, si era un grupo de más de 4 niños, anotá, grupo de cuantos niños. Poné M para niños y F para las niñas; si era un grupo mixto, anotá M/F. Anotá la edad que tenían los niños cuando empezaste a cuidarlos años/meses. Anotá la edad que tenían los niños cuando los dejaste de cuidar años/meses. Si es un grupo de niños, anotá la edad del más pequeño y la del más grande cuando comenzaste a cuidarlos y la edad del más pequeño y la del más grande cuando dejaste de cuidarlos.

En el lado derecho:

Anota el nombre de la persona que te supervisó cuando cuidaste a estos niños, por ejemplo, la mamá, el director del campamento, etc. Esta persona es la misma que te deberá firmar una hoja de Childcare Referente (Referencia de cuidado de niños).

Started: Anotá el mes / año en que empezaste a cuidar a los niños de esta experiencia

Ended: Anotá el mes/año en que dejaste de cuidar a los niños

Average number of days per month: Anotá el número de días durante el mes que los cuidas (Por ejemplo, 8 días al mes si son todos los fines de semana, o 20 días si los cuidas de lunes a viernes durante el mes, etc)

Average number of hours per day?: Anotá el número de horas que los cuidas cada día. Si es variable, anota un promedio de horas.

Si alguno de los niños que cuidabas es menor o era menos de 2 años anota YES

En las líneas siguientes a cada experiencia, describe las actividades realizadas con los niños; si les cocinabas, leías, jugabas en el parque, llevabas a la escuela, si les ayudas a hacer la tarea, etc..

Por favor confirmá todas las experiencias que has tenido con bebés y niños

En esta sección deberás listar las habilidades de cuidado de niños, menores de 2 años de lado izquierdo y mayores de 2 años a la derecha, y que tan seguido lo hacías.

Pregunta #26b

En esta sección indicá si seguirás cuidando de niños antes de partir. Si vas a continuar, a la familia le gustará mucho saberlo!

Pregunta #27 y 27a

Incluye niños con necesidades especiales, síndrome de down, parálisis cerebral, autismo, deficiencia de aprendizaje, etc..

Pregunta #28

No seas modesta, si eres muy buena en algo, escribilo! Si eres buena en algún deporte, has tomado algún curso de primeros auxilios, cocinas bien etc. También podés escribir sobre tus logros personales.

Pregunta #29

Incluyen ser líder de campamento, capitán en la escuela, de algún equipo o instructor etc.

Pregunta #31

Anotá todas las actividades que te sea posible! Completa todo el espacio y agrega mas información en alguna hoja adjunta incluso. Las familias querrán saber que verdaderamente podrás mantener a los niños ocupados en cualquier momento.

Pregunta #32 y 33

Pregunta de SUMA IMPORTANCIA para la familia anfitriona por lo que debes asegurarte de que tu respuesta sea inteligente, pensada y clara.

No olvides firmar y anotar la fecha el final de la página 4!

Aplicación página 5

Personal letter

Esta es tu oportunidad de escribir sobre vos, tu familia, intereses, amigos y el lugar donde vivís. Escribe sobre tus experiencias en el cuidado de niños. Pensá que quien lea esta carta será una posible familia que se estará preguntando al leer, por que deberá seleccionarte como su au pair. Contales porqué te gustaría ser Au Pair y que es lo que más te gusta de los niños. Incluí algo simpático que te haya pasado mientras cuidabas a los niños, o el mejor recuerdo que tengas de esto. Podés utilizar la hoja que viene dentro de esta aplicación o bien, usar otra hoja. Sé creativa! Podés usar papel de colores, de preferencia claros, stickers, hacer dibujos, etc. Tu carta debe ser escrita a mano, no en computadora. Igualmente te sugerimos hacer un borrador antes de la carta final. La carta final no debe estar tachada, ni podrás usar corrector. Puede que tu carta no sea en un inglés perfecto, pero no debe tener errores de ortografía, consulta tu diccionario para escribir correctamente.

Au pair children reference y personal reference

Es necesario llenar CORRECTAMENTE y entregar estos formatos para ser aceptada en el programa:

1. Debés adjuntar por lo menos 3 referencias personales que no sean de familiares (no incluyas referencias de amigos de la misma edad que tu, las familias prefieren leer las referencias de personas mayores que tu, por ejemplo, tus maestros o las mamás de tus amigas)
 2. Debés agregar también por lo menos 2 referencias de cuidado infantil cubriendo un mínimo de 200 horas de experiencia. Estas referencias deben ser de personas distintas a las referencias personales y deben coincidir con las experiencias que anotaste en las páginas 3 y 4.
- Si anotas como experiencia que has cuidado a tus hermanos, anota a otro adulto que no sea de tu familia como referencia como por ejemplo algún vecino o algún amigo de la familia que lo pueda constatar. Asegurate de anotar que esta experiencia es cuidando familiares.
 - Las referencias deben contestar TODAS las preguntas! Las familias anfitrionas leen cuidadosamente las referencias al seleccionar a su Au pair por que les interesa saber como te perciben los demás y si confían en vos. Pedíles a quienes llenan tus referencias que contesten de la forma más completa. Si ellos consideran que sos la mejor, que lo digan! Si las personas que te dan la referencia no hablan inglés, que te la escriban en español y vos las podés traducir, pero SI O SI, ellos la stienen que firmar tambien!
 - Te recomendamos enviar más de 4 referencias si es posible. Entre más mejor! Es importante que las personas que te recomiendan, sean fáciles de localizar, si no se les puede localizar, tu proceso de búsqueda de una familia será detenido. También debes explicarles a las personas que te recomiendan que les van a llamar y que su opinión es importante, no solo deben decir, “si, la recomiendo” deben decir por que!

Photo Collage

- Por favor utilizá papel de colores claros, tamaño carta o A4, ya que tu aplicación será escaneada. Usa fotos de buena calidad y tinta de color negro. Deberás enviar más de una página, incluyendo fotos con niños, en dónde te veas feliz interactuando con ellos, otra con tu familia, otra con amigos y otra de las actividades que te guste hacer.
- No incluyas fotos en bares o fiestas, dónde salgas tú o tus amigas con bebidas alcohólicas o fumando, con ropa inadecuada (remeritas escotadas, minis, bikinis etc) o gente desnuda.
- Usá tu imaginación para hacer tu collage de la forma más creativa e incluye una pequeña explicación de cada foto.
- Escribí tu nombre en todas las hojas y asegurate que se vea bonito, limpio y no se despegue nada.



Driver's licence

Debés incluir una copia de tu licencia de conducir. Si tenés tu primera licencia de conducir, enviános una copia. Si no tenemos copia de tu licencia de conducir, tu proceso será detenido hasta que la tengas y nos envíes la copia.

Health Certificate

Deberás completar la forma de Personal Health Information vos misma y entregarla junto con tu aplicación. Tu doctor deberá llenar la evaluación Physician's Health/Certificate of Health. Esta evaluación podrá ser enviada a la oficina después (por lo menos 6 semanas antes de que viajes). El Physician's Health/Certificate of Health debe ser tramitado máximo 6 meses antes de tu fecha de partida, para que esté vigente. Considerá que si alguna enfermedad se te presenta antes de viajar, la familia anfitriona deberá saberlo y evaluarán si desean que tu seas su au pair o decidan buscar a alguien mas. Recuerda que para entrar en el programa debes gozar de buena salud.

Criminal Record

Debes solicitar un certificado que certifique que no presentás antecedentes penales en tu delegación o municipio. Solamente aquellos que no tengan antecedente penales podrán participar en el programa de Cultural Care Au pair. Deberás mandarnos el certificado original por lo menos 4 semanas antes de que viajes. Puede tomarte algunas semanas para obtenerla, por lo que te sugerimos nos preguntes en qué momento debes comenzar el trámite.

Passport/Visa application

Tu pasaporte será necesario para que puedas tramitar tu visa. Si aún no tienes pasaporte es necesario que lo tramites de inmediato. Si ya lo tenés, asegurate de que tenga validez de por lo menos 6 meses después de tu regreso a Argentina de otro modo deberás tramitar un nuevo pasaporte. Los formatos para la visa e instrucciones para tramitarla, te serán enviados una vez que tengas una familia confirmada para viajar. Posteriormente aplicarás para una visa tipo J-1.

Documentation of education

Debes anexar una copia de tu analíoc del secundario or el certificado de título en trámite. No mandes los originales. No podrás viajar si no has terminado els ecundario, es decir que no podes deber ninguna materia.

Diplomas and certificates

Si has hecho algo de lo que estés muy orgullosa y te gustaría que la familia lo sepa, puedes anexar diplomas o certificados. Recordá sólo enviar copias- no los originales. Es muy importante que incluyas certificados de inglés y de primeros auxilios. También es buena idea que incluyas cosas personales que son importantes para ti, por ejemplo un dibujo de algún niño al que hayas cuidado, o si se te gusta, un poema o un dibujo realizado por ti!

Otros

No olvides anexar una foto de tamaño pasaporte a color

Por último...

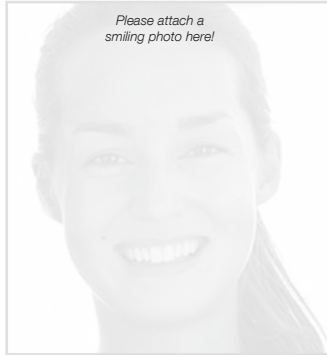

with personal identification number _____ ("I", "me" or "my"), for good and valuable consideration, understand and agree to the following terms and conditions (the "Agreement") relating to the au pair's participation in Cultural Care Au Pair US au pair program (the "Program").

1. In addition to the terms of this Agreement, I agree to abide by additional reasonable terms and conditions stipulated by CC during the Program, including the Extension program. If there is any confusion between this Agreement and the terms of any other contracts, agreements, or materials of any kind, the terms of this Agreement shall prevail.
2. I agree to comply with the Program regulations issued by the United States Department of State (22 CFR Part 62) ("Regulations"). I acknowledge receipt of a copy of the Regulations as they apply to me. I also understand that I must comply with CC's rules as outlined in this Agreement, the Au Pair Handbooks and other materials that CC has supplied to me. This includes staying within the legal number of working hours per day and week without exception. I will inform my Local Childcare Coordinator if asked to work beyond the legal guidelines of the program as outlined by the U.S. Department of State Regulations.
3. I understand that providing childcare is my primary obligation in this Program and that any personal plans or activities will take secondary priority to caring for my host children. I agree to perform the child care responsibilities outlined by my host family to the best of my ability, and make every effort to act as a caring, responsible host family member, including abiding by the household rules. I understand that my host family may ask me to respect a curfew and/or assign other reasonable restrictions designed to protect the safety and well-being of my host children. I agree to abide by such reasonable restrictions. I also understand that I may not post photos or personal information about my host family, host children, or host home on any web site, blog or the like without the express written consent of my host parents.
4. I agree to attend and actively participate in all child safety and child development training and orientation sessions sponsored by CC. This includes thoroughly reading all written materials provided to me including the Au Pair Handbook and any other pre-departure materials.
5. I shall submit a refundable deposit to CC as outlined by the local office where I was trained and interviewed. This fee will be refunded (or applied to my return flight in select countries) after the successful completion of the Program, unless forfeited in accordance with this Agreement. CC shall make the final determination as to what currency I will be refunded in and whether the fee is refunded while I am in the USA or back in my home country after my program period. If my deposit is to be returned in my home country, I understand that in order to receive the refund I must submit for the refund within thirty (30) days of my CC return flight date to prove that I returned on time in compliance with the rules of my J-1 visa.
6. During my participation in the Program I will abide by all local, state and federal laws and other regulations. I understand that breaking these laws (such as shoplifting, driving under the influence of alcohol, possession, or use of illegal substances, etc.) shall be grounds for my immediate dismissal from the program and my deposit and return flight will be forfeited.
7. I will only use medications as prescribed to me and approved by a treating physician. I understand that I may only consume alcohol if I am of legal drinking age, and I agree not to consume alcoholic beverages to excess at any time or to drive under the influence of alcohol. I further agree not to consume alcoholic beverages at any time while I am on duty.
8. I understand that I may not use the family's automobile(s) for any reason without express permission from the host family and that any agreement to use the host family's automobile is strictly between the host family and me. I will not use the automobile unless the host family has obtained all of the mandatory automobile insurance coverage required under the laws of the state where the host family resides.
9. I agree to pay any personal expenses I incur while participating in the Program, including but not limited to, health expenses not covered by insurance, phone bills and/or car damages. If I leave the host family with unpaid bills, I understand that CC will have the right to withhold my deposit or collect from me otherwise until I have paid the host family. CC is not responsible for any financial disputes I have with my host family such as outstanding money for educational component, weekly stipend, etc. I understand that I must settle all disputes directly with my host family prior to my departure from their home.
10. I understand that my Local Childcare Coordinator and the Cultural Care staff in the U.S. are my primary contacts during the Program, and are responsible for ensuring a positive and successful program year for me and my host family. I will notify the staff of CC in the U.S. in case of disagreement, misunderstanding or serious problems including but not limited to my health, safety, welfare, adjustment to my host family, school, culture or language, or misunderstandings or problems with my host family. I acknowledge that CC is solely responsible for choosing appropriate host families for me and I will not make attempts to obtain placements on my own after my arrival in the U.S. In situations where I am having problems with my host family, I agree to consult with and meet with my Local Childcare Coordinator and to follow CC's mediation guidelines as outlined in the Au Pair Handbook. I understand that it is CC's policy to try to resolve issues in the existing placement if possible before considering a new placement.
11. If the problems within my host family cannot be resolved, I understand that it is CC policy to seek a recommendation from my host family and Local Childcare Coordinator in order to find me a new family. If positive recommendations cannot be obtained, I understand that I may not be eligible for replacement. Should the proper recommendations be obtained, I agree that efforts for replacement will be contingent upon my flexibility regarding preferences such as, state, region, and car use. I understand that CC will use reasonable efforts for two weeks to find another host family for me. During such time, I shall continue to live with my current host family who, in its discretion, may request me to provide, or not to provide, any childcare services

and I shall remain reachable by phone/email with CC at all times. If I do not perform childcare duties during the transition period (even if I am staying with a host family) I understand that I will not receive the weekly stipend. CC will make every effort to present appropriate host families to me. Should I reject these host families for reasons of geographical region, car/computer use or other non-essential reasons I understand that CC may opt to discontinue a search for replacement. I understand that CC cannot guarantee a new family placement for me within the two-week transition period and inability to be replaced will result in my early return to my home country. I understand that if CC cannot otherwise replace me in a new home through no fault of my own I will be entitled to return of my deposit.

12. I understand that CC has the exclusive right to determine my suitability for acceptance and for my continued participation in the Program. I understand that if CC determines that my emotional or physical state does not make me suitable for providing quality childcare, I will be removed from the Program. I also understand that should I marry or become pregnant while on the Program I will also be removed from the Program. If my performance as an au pair and/or participation in the program is deemed unsatisfactory by CC for whatever reason, CC will reassess my suitability for future placement. I understand that I may be terminated from the Program if I do not successfully complete the Program requirements and uphold Program expectations for reasons including, but not limited to, the following: leaving the host family without prior consent from CC; engaging in behavior that CC deems inappropriate during the Program duration, performance reasons including but not limited to breaking host family rules, neglectful or inappropriate behavior towards the children, etc.; non-participation in training, not fulfilling educational credit, non-attendance at monthly meetings, or if I in any way violate this Agreement. I further understand that should it be discovered that I have falsified or withheld critical information from my application materials including, but not limited to, health conditions, criminal history, educational documentation, childcare experience, etc. I may be terminated from the Program.
13. I understand that the Program is designated as a full year program with the possibility to extend for a further six (6), nine (9) or twelve (12) months. Should I voluntarily decide to return home before the regular end date of my program (including extension period) I understand that my flight will not be paid for and my deposit not returned. The exception to this will be in cases of my own extreme illness or the extreme illness or a death in my immediate family. Should I terminate or be terminated from the Program for any reason as outlined in this agreement, such termination will result in the following:
 - a) I will forfeit the return ticket and I will be required to make my own arrangements to return to my home country at my own expense; and
 - b) I will forfeit the refundable deposit; and
 - c) My CC insurance coverage will no longer be valid and no part of it refunded other than the 13th month optional insurance; and
 - d) My status will be reported to U.S. Immigration and my participation in the au pair program will be canceled.
 - e) CC will not provide me with housing in the USA.
14. CC will arrange my flights from and to my home country, from a CC approved gateway. I am responsible for my own transportation and the cost involved to the specified departure gateway in my home country. My departure date to the US (Group Arrival Date), will be determined by my availability and my host family's request. Should I cancel either of the included flights once the ticket has been issued, I understand that I will then be held responsible for any penalties and costs relating to this cancellation. CC will determine my return date based on the end date of my program and my host family gateway will be my return gateway. Special requests may be considered, however additional fees may apply and these costs will be my responsibility. I understand that CC cannot book my return flight for a date later than thirty (30) days after completion of my Program.
15. This agreement is made between me and CC. In regards to confidentiality, CC agrees not to divulge medical or confidential information about me or my Program experience to any third party except in case of medical emergency. As a person of the age of majority I understand that this also includes my parents or family members as well as any partner or friends. Any disputes will be settled between me and CC or any legal entity bound to represent us and no other third party.
16. I agree to irrevocably, unconditionally, and fully remise, release and forever discharge CC and its affiliates; and said persons' respective officers, directors, successors, assigns, attorneys, insurance companies, agents, employees and affiliates, or others to the extent acting or purporting to act on the afore mentioned persons' behalf (all of said persons hereinafter, in the aggregate, being referred to as "Released Parties"), from any and all claims or causes of action which I have or may hereafter have, which arise out of illness, injury, damage or loss of any other kind to me or my property resulting from or during participation in the Program. This includes, without limitation, my performance of services for and involvement with the host family, regardless of how such illness, injury, damage or loss may arise. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any losses, claims, damages or liabilities related to or arising out of my participation in the Program, including (without limitation) any illness, injury or damage to me, that my host family causes, that any third party causes, that I cause or to which I contribute, and any illness, injury or damage to my host family which I cause or to which I contribute.
17. This Agreement shall take effect as a sealed instrument under and shall be governed by the laws of Switzerland. In the event of any claim, dispute, or proceeding arising out of the relationship of me and CC, or any claim which in contract, tort, or otherwise at law or in equity arises between the parties, whether or not related to this Agreement, the parties submit and consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the arbitral tribunals of Switzerland.
18. My signature on this agreement indicates acceptance of this Agreement and is legally binding. No alterations to the terms of this agreement will be valid unless approved in writing by CC. If any provision of this agreement shall be deemed unenforceable, such paragraph shall be omitted and the remainder of the agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent allowed by law.
